## The most important events in our library's life – chronological:

- <u>1926</u> Town Council's act for setting up of two libraries (Hungarian and Slovak Municipal library)
- <u>1945</u> most of the books damaged during the bombing of Nové Zámky, only 3000 volumes preserved
- <u>1951</u> a decree of then Ministry of Culture established district Library
- <u>1956</u> Library transferred into the building of the roman-catholic parish at the Main Square
- <u>1972</u> department of political literature set up at the Town Council at the Main Square
- 1973 Launch of the regional journal "Knihovnícky svit" and "Knihovníček"
- <u>1975</u> a lending facility opened at the Retirement Home
- <u>1976</u> second division opened (SNP 32 street)
- <u>1977</u> district library transferred to the administrative building in Turecká street (except children and educational literature department
- <u>1979</u> music department opened; first librarian's week organized
- <u>1985</u> musical youth club set up at the library
- <u>1989</u> department of bibliography and regionalistics set up; science-fiction club "Orion" founded
- <u>1991</u> first PC, copy machine and software "PARIS" bought for the department of educational literature
- <u>1992</u> BISYS license acquired; third division opened
- <u>1993</u> Micro CDS/ISIS license acquired, version 2.3
- <u>1994</u> the library become a part of Slovak Library of Matej Hrebenda for the blind and started providing services for the blind and tender-eyed
- <u>1996</u> the library changed its name for "Požitavská knižnica"; lost its legal entity and became part of "Požitavské regionálne centrum"; automatization of the library funds using SMART LIB 3.0 software; Literary club set up

- <u>1997</u> two stages of renovation of the scientific and technical department completed with building of four galleries that doubled the space of the department
- <u>1999</u> regaining of legal entity by the foundation decree of Regional Authority in Nitra; Child's book day in cooperation with "Bibiana" international art centre for children
- <u>2000</u> library renamed as "Knižnica Anton Bernoláka v Nových Zámkoch" (Anton Bernolák is buried in Nové Zámky); further improvement of library automatization by a multi-user information system RAPID LIBRARY; engaged in civil association PRO BIBLIOTEKA – aiming at creation of a virtual index catalogue; connected to the Internet and own page created; fine art club set up
- <u>2001</u> library transferred to a temporary place, former kindergarten in Božena Němcová Street due to an overall renovation of the building of Slovenská poisťovňa a.s.
